Salzburg is a city made famous by it's music, home to Mozart and the „Sound of Music“. You will have time to explore the quaint cobbled old town, the cathedral and medieval fortress before crossing the river to stroll through the pretty gardens of the Mirabell Palace. An optional city tour on foot, guided by a local Salzburg City Guide, will take you through the highlights of the city including Mozart Square, the Residence Buildings and Getreidegasse and will give you an insight into the varied history of this impressive city. The optional city tour can be booked and paid for on the coach and costs € 9,- per adult , 6 - 12 years € 4,50. The city tours is free for children under 6 years and takes approx 1 - 1 ¼ hrs. Passports are Required on this excursion.

This is a delightful visit to the world's fifth and Europe's highest waterfall, a 380m spectacular drop, set in the Hohe Tauern National Park, the largest Nationalpark in Central Europe. Simply enjoy the striking scenery from the foot of the falls, or follow the pathway near the waterfall's edge for a closer look. The walk to the middle falls takes approximately 30 minutes.

Strong shoes are recommended. The entrance fee to the falls is included.

Visit the Royal Bavarian Spa town, famous for its old working salt mines (optional € 17,- adult, € 9,50 child from 4 – 15 years) and Hitler's Eagles Nest (optional € 16,60 adult, € 9,60 child up to 14 years).

Salt mining has a long tradition in Berchtesgaden. The wealth of the whole region has its origin in the white gold. You will be given a guided tour of the complex tunnel system, which makes up part of the 500 year old mine, and will discover the origins of the famous Bad Reichenhall salt.

The road leading from Obersalzburg (formerly Hitler's home and southern headquarters) to the Eagle's Nest parking lot is widely considered to be a real feat of engineering. Perched at 1.834m (6.017 ft), the building itself was a project of Martin Bormann's and given to Adolf Hitler for his 50th birthday as a teahouse for diplomats.

Passports are required on this excursion, It is possible to visit either the Salt Mines or the Eagle's Nest during the excursion. For those guests wishing to visit neither the Salt Mines nor the Eagle's Nest, there is a time to explore the Bavarian town of Berchtesgaden.

This is a scenic trip into the Hohe Tauern Nationalpark, on the High Alpine Road, which leads to the glacial base of Austria's highest mountain, the Grossglockner (3798m). Be amazed by the spectacular scenery of the area and the incredible engineering feat of the Grossglockner road. The Grossglockner High Alpine Road has been an incomparable experience for about fifty million visitors since 1935.

On the ascent from 1.500m to the Kaiser-Franz-Josef-Höhe, you pass through all of the vegetation zones from the cornfields to the eternal ice. There will be opportunities to photograph this marvellous road, alpine scenery and wildlife, as well as learn more about them in Visitor Center Exhibitions at the Franz-Josefs-Höhe (free of charge).

You will make a brief stop in the picturesque, lakeside town of Zell am See in Salzburgerland before returning to Tyrol. Visit the 11th century church, stroll through the pedestrianised area or along the lakeside path.

This is a delightful tour of some of the lesser-known lakes surrounding the Wilder Kaiser Mountain range. You will begin your tour in the pictureque Kaiserbachtal, before a stop at Walchsee Lake, where there are many cafes and restaurants for lunch (not included).

Your tour continues to the remote lake of Hechtsee above the town of Kufstein. Stroll around this lake at your leisure (approximately 45 minutes) or enjoy the views from the cafe's terrace overlooking the lake. Explore the narrow, cobbled streets of Kufstein, dominated by its 13th century fortress before continuing on via the beautiful Rein valley lakes to the medieval town of Rattenberg on the River Inn. This tour is a photographer's delight.
